## How to make pinecone hedgehogs



## You need

1. Pinecones
2. Felt
3. Googly eyes
4. Glue
5. Scissors

First you need to cut a shape out of the felt for the face. We cut a rounded kind of triangle shape for

ours.



Glue the face on. We used PVA glue, which did work, but if you have something stronger it would

last longer.



Glue on 2 googly eyes, then cut out a small black circular piece of felt and glue it on for the nose and there you have a very simple, but cute looking hedgehog.

## You need

1. Felt
2. Scissors
3. Glue
4. Googly eyes
5. Pipe cleaner

To make a rabbit is very similar to the hedgehog. First make bunny ears shapes with the pipe

cleaner and twist it round the top of the pinecone.
